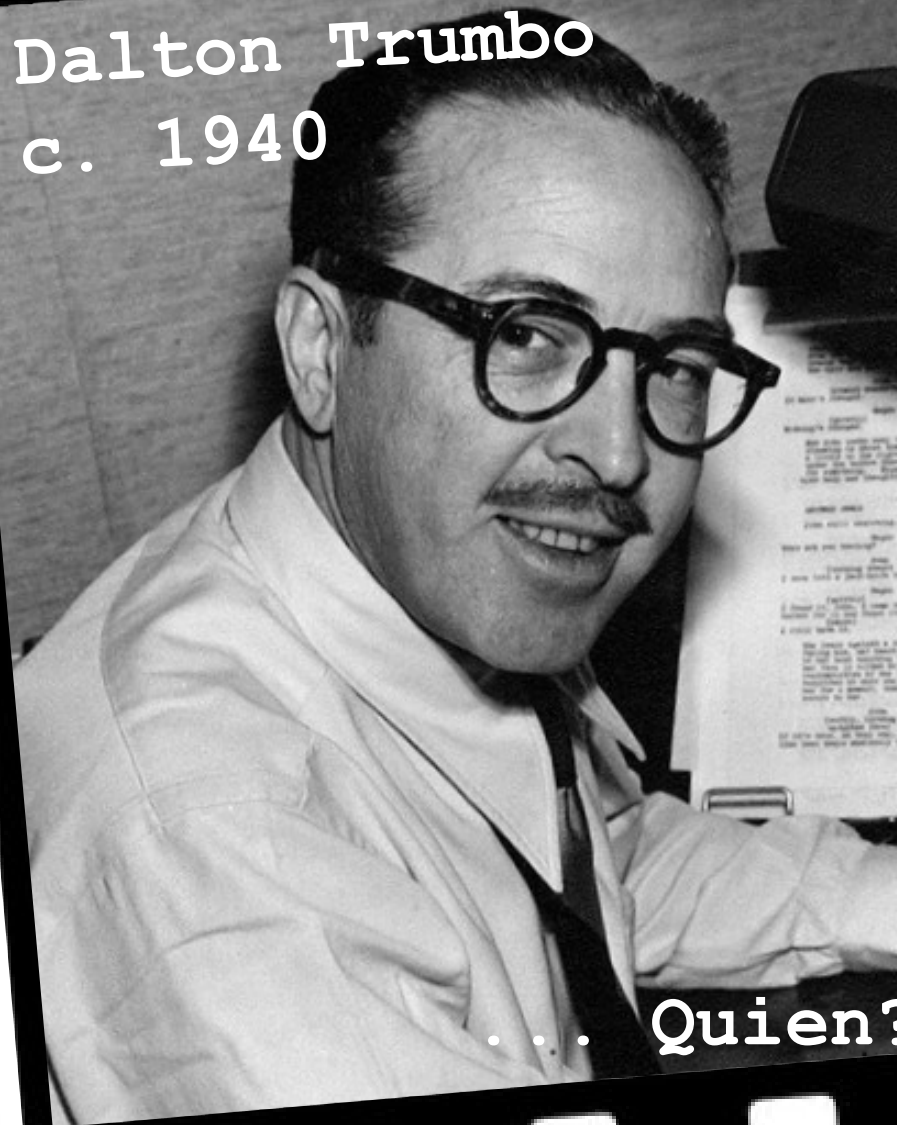
MEMORANDUM FOR THE DIRECTOR

Re: CHARLES CHAPLIN
INFORMATION CONCERNING

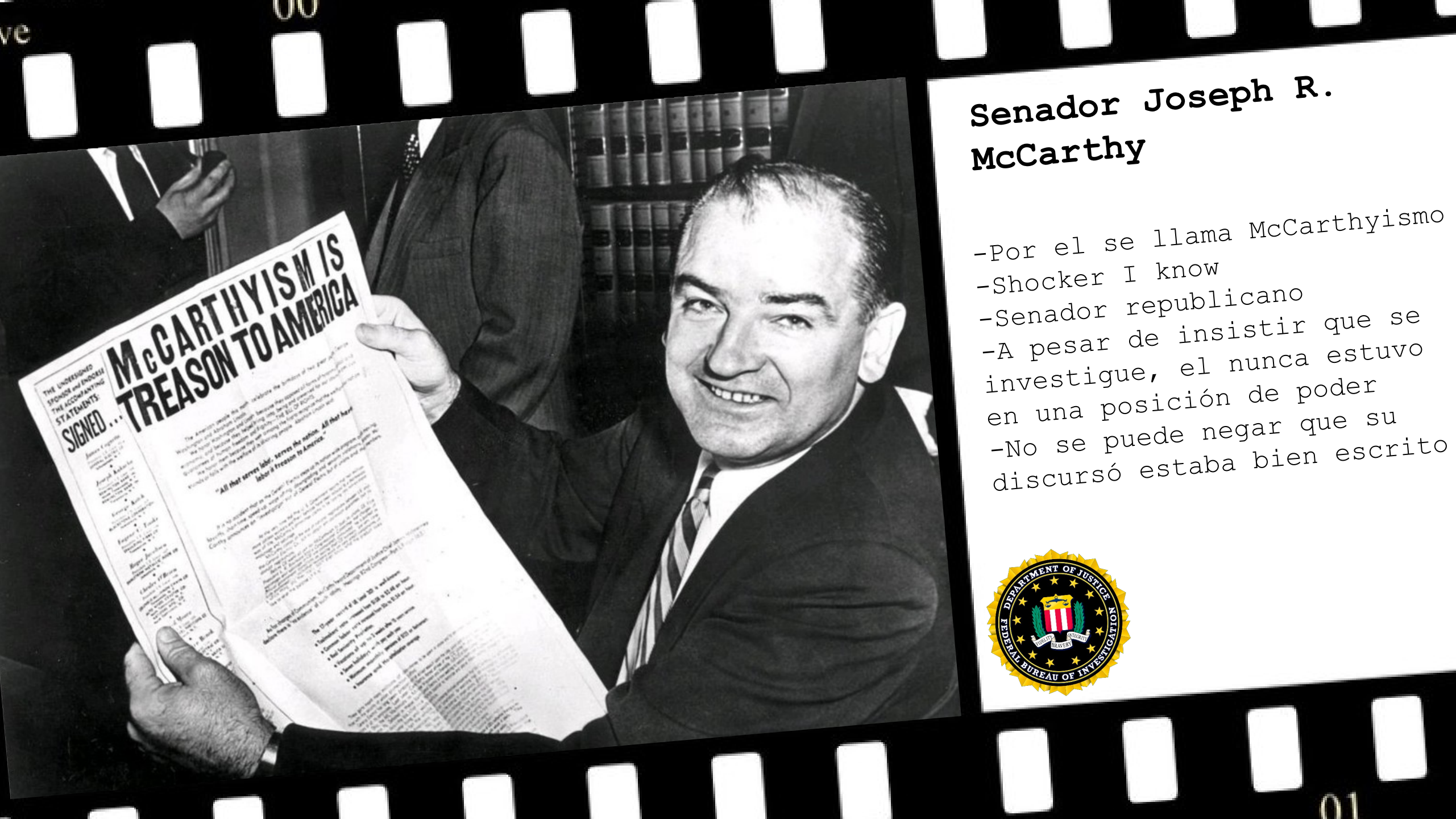

the following information obtained in which I believe
you will be interested.

A few days before CHAPLIN was married he telephonically communicated with [REDACTED] who was formerly associated with CHAPLIN [REDACTED] and advised [REDACTED] at that time that he contemplated marrying CONA O'NEILL. Because of the unfavorable publicity received by ROBERT ARDEN, an intimate of CHAPLIN'S and a local radio commentator concerning whom the Bureau has previously been advised inasmuch as attempts were made to obtain citizenship for him by a special Act in Congress, CHAPLIN did not desire to advise ARDEN of his present plans nor did he desire one of his associates, TIM DUBOIS, to know of his contemplated marriage because of unfavorable publicity that might result, inasmuch as it is a known fact that DUBOIS lives with a colored girl named KATHLEEN DUBOIS, a part-time actress. [REDACTED] volunteered to be of any assistance to CHAPLIN in his plan because of his long-time friendship [REDACTED]

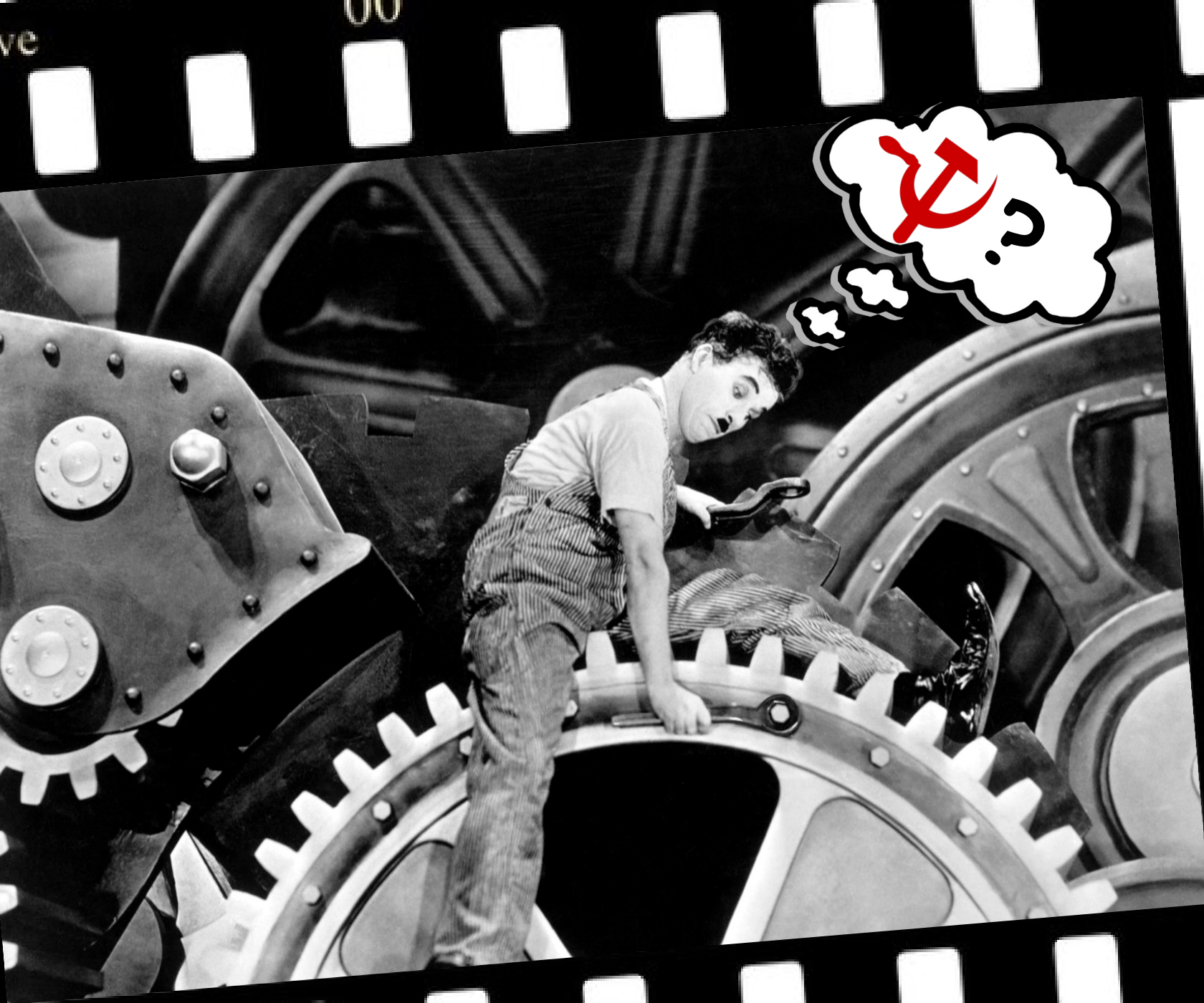

HOLLYWOOD 10 CHARGED WITH CONTEMPT

House Reacts to Lawson Dodge of Red Question

WASHINGTON, D.C. Nov. 24 - The House Committee on Un-American Activities, ruling that John Howard Lawson, screen writer, had refused to answer as to his membership in the Communist Party, moved today to bring a citation against him for contempt of Congress.

Meanwhile, Eric Johnson, president of the motion picture association, told the committee to "expose communism, but don't put any American who isn't a Communist in a concentration camp of suspicion." He said that the motion picture industry should retain the right to decide what will or will not go into our pictures.

It was a day for announcements as the committee opened the second week of its inquiry into the alleged Communist saturation into the film industry. Mr. Johnson presented one scoring the committee for the course of its investigative procedures. The committee, after briefly interviewing Mr. Lawson, read into the record a memorandum, containing thirty-five points and, running over 5,000 words on the Communist affiliations of the writer.

CHAPLIN SHOWS HIS 'MOST CONTROVERSIAL FILM'

He laughs at life — especially life in America

But Charles isn't as funny as Charlie

FIVE minutes ago I was helplessly laughing at the sight of Charlie Chaplin in his new film, "A King in New York," riding in a lift with his finger stuck in the nozzle of a fire hose.

He escaped only by taking the complete hose with him to appear before the Committee of Un-American Activities and accidentally spraying them when his finger gets loose.

My stomach muscles are still aching, my ribs are a little sore and my eyes moist.

That is the physical answer to many of the foolish things that have been said about this film, which was specially shown today and will open in the West End on Thursday.

Chaplin's new film was made without any ballyhoo or publicity behind locked doors in England.

It is the most controversial film ever made by the cinema's greatest genius. It has been bitterly criticised as "a brutal satire on the American way of life."
